"From 25- to 55-year-old vines, the 2014 Côtes du Rhône Premieres Cotes (60% Grenache, 30% Syrah and 10% Mourvèdre) is raised mostly in concrete tanks, with 12% in old demi-muids.

Creme de cassis, blackberry, violets and floral characteristics all emerge from this medium-bodied, seamless, sexy Côtes du Rhône that should drink nicely for 5-7 years."
